1. I understand that when my child is enrolled as a student at Kemper Academy, he or she is subject to the rules and regulations of Kemper Academy.
2. Acceptance of new students is subject to the approval of the Kemper Academy Head of School and Board of Directors.
3. Elementary students transferring to Kemper Academy may be required to take an entrance exam for accurate grade level placement.
4. I hereby give permission for my child to take part in all school activities and absolve the school, administrators or member of the Board of Directors from any liability because of any injury to my child at school or to and from school activities.
5. No student will be accepted requiring separate special education classes because Kemper Academy is not equipped to be of the best service to such a student. If this problem is known at time of enrollment, proper action will be taken to have the child tested and evaluated for appropriate placement or referred to another school in the best interest of the child.
6. All students are expected to maintain standards of academic achievement and general citizenship relative to the requirement established. Failure to do so will be just cause for the student's withdrawal from Kemper Academy.
7. Parents of students must have paid their registration fees and signed a contract for the student to be eligible for any tryouts relative to the next school year.
8. Athletic eligibility requirements of the Midsouth Association of Independent Schools must be followed concerning all athletes.
9. Application and contracts must be completed and **SIGNED** before admittance is guaranteed.
