



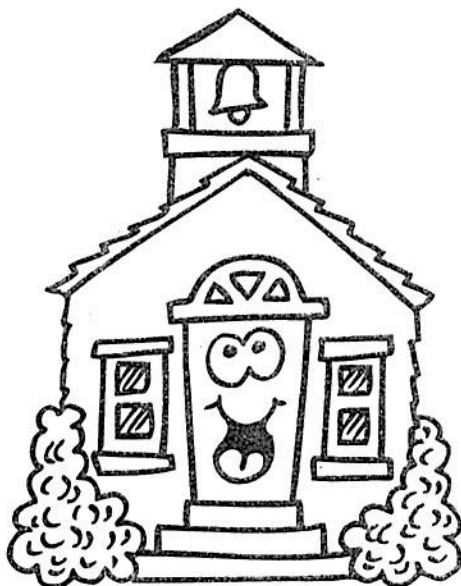
Dear Parents and Students,

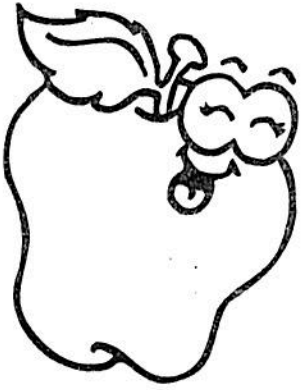
Again, I welcome you to fourth grade and look forward to a great year of working together as we watch your child grow. Have a wonderful summer!!
