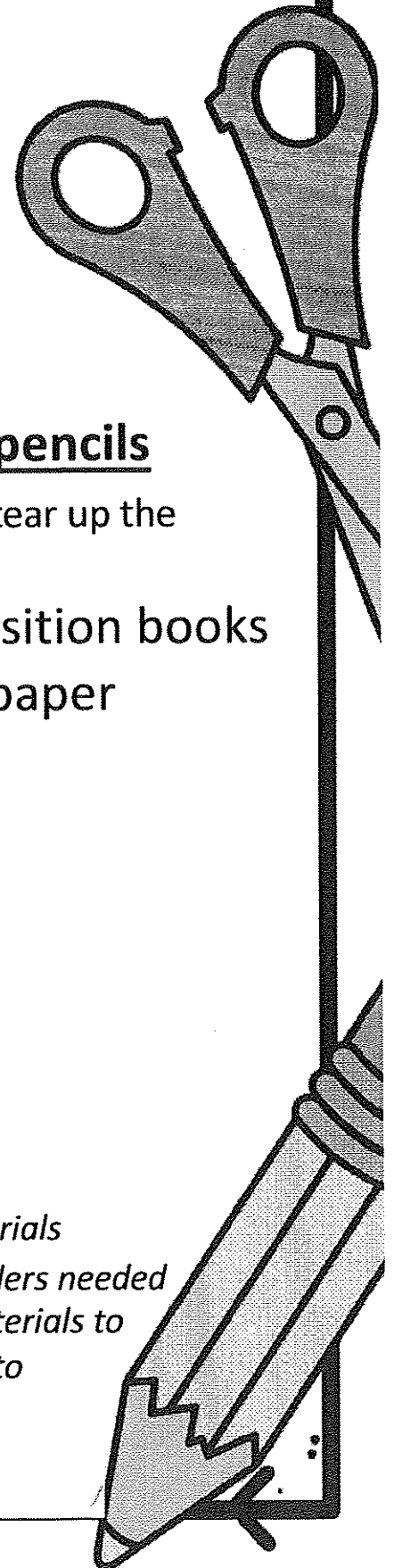
I am excited about seeing each one of you in August!

## Kemper Academy 5<sup>th</sup> Grade




- #2 wooden pencils - no mechanical pencils
