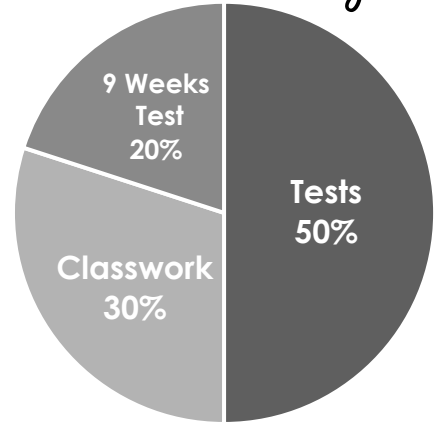
## Classwork
